Thin Blue Line Act (H.R. 99)	Rep. Vern Buchanan (R-FL)	Provides additional aggravating factors for the imposition of the death penalty based on the status of the victim.	Support	House Judiciary Committee
LEOSA Reform Act (H.R. 1156)	Rep. Don Bacon (R-NE)	Improves LEOSA law to expand concealed carry permissions for qualified active and retired law enforcement officers, among other things.	Support	House Judiciary Committee
Extreme Risk Protection Order Act (H.R. 1236/S. 506)	Rep. Salud Carbajal (D-CA); Sen. Dianne Feinstein (D-CA)	Supports State, Tribal, and local efforts to remove access to firearms from individuals who are a danger to themselves or others pursuant to court orders for this purpose. School Resource Officer Act (H.R. 916)	Rep. Paul Mitchell (R-MI)	Amends the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to require a certain percentage of COPS grant funds to be used for the salaries and benefits of school resource officers, and for other purposes.
